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PREFACE

The Self-Financing Paramedical Managements Association (**SPMA**) represents **25** Paramedical college / institutes in Kerala (Registration no. R- 63/07 dated 24.1.2007)

The Association is entrusted with admissions to the Member Colleges / Institute since 2007, collectively and purely on the basis of merit. Merit was being determined based on the marks obtained for the relevant subjects in the qualifying examinations as per the guidelines of KUHS / DME as well as under the guideline of the Admission Fee Regulatory Committee (AFRC) for PG, Degree, and Diploma courses respectively.

Admission to various paramedical PG, Degree and Diploma programmes for the academic year 2025-26 is as per the guidelines of KUHS, DME & AFRC.

SELF-FINANCING PARAMEDICAL MANAGEMENT ASSOCIATION (SPMA)

Self-Financing Paramedical Management Association (SPMA) is a voluntary self-regulatory agency of Self-Financing Paramedical Colleges / Institutes in Kerala. We ensure high quality education in various PG, Degree and Diploma paramedical programs without compromising on social justice. We value transparency at all junctures of professional education. Our member institutes listed in Annexure I are desirous of adopting a common admission procedure for various paramedical programs ensuring transparency through merit-based admission in a non-exploitative manner. This prospectus is issued to govern the admission process in the participating Colleges/Institutes for the academic year 2025-26.

1. Introduction

- 1.1 This prospectus relates to admission to various PG, Degree and Diploma programmes under the Paramedical stream as detailed in clause **1.1** and conducted at participating colleges / institutions. The names, addresses, programmes offered, the intake capacity and contact details of member institutions are given as in **Annexure –I.**
- **1.2** The association has decided to conduct a separate selection procedure for the admission of candidates For various Paramedical programs in PG, UG and Diploma.
- **1.3** This prospectus contains the rules and regulations applicable for selection and admission to various paramedical programs for 2025-26 in the institutions to management seats as per the AFRC.
- **1.4** The prospectus is common for all the Member Colleges and will be binding to them.

There is no individual policy or reservation by the member colleges unless otherwise specified.

2. Criteria of eligibility for admission.

2.1 Nationality:

Candidates must be citizens of India / or dependents of Non-Resident Indians

2.2 Academic

2.2.1 Admission Requirements:

PG courses:

Master of Hospital Administration (MHA): As per the KUHS admission criteria, pass in any full-time regular degree with 50% marks from UGC recognized university.

Master of Optometry: The Candidate shall pass B.Sc.Optometry with 55% of marks as per KUHS norms.

MSc.MLT (Biochemistry), MSc.MLT (Pathology) and MSc.MLT (Microbiology): Candidate who have passed the BSc.MLT degree from Kerala University of Health Sciences or from any other University recognized equivalent there to by KUHS with 50% marks for all the years of BSc.MLT examination.

Degree: Candidates who have passed the Higher Secondary examination of the Board of

Higher Secondary Education, Kerala, or examinations recognized equivalent thereto, with 50% marks of 12th class in Physics, Chemistry and Biology put together are eligible as per KUHS norms.

Diploma: The candidate shall pass higher secondary examination of Govt. of Kerala or equivalent recognized by DME, Govt. of Kerala with a minimum of 40% marks in physics, chemistry and biology.

No rounding off of the percentage of marks to the nearest whole number is permitted. For example, a score of 50 marks out of 100 or 150 marks out of 300 alone will be considered as 50% marks and scores of 45 out of 100 or 135 out of 300 alone will be considered as 45% marks for determining eligibility.

2.2.2 Medium of Instruction:

The medium of instruction and examination shall be English

2.2.3 Affiliation of College: All PG and Degree programs are affiliated with the Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS). The Diploma programs are approved by the Directorate of Medical Education (DME), Govt.of Kerala.

2.2.4 Duration:

Duration of the program shall be of two years for all diploma programs, and the DOTAT course duration will be 2 years with six months of internship for those who have passed the course as per DME norms (2.5yrs) and DRRT will be 3 years.

Degree program duration shall be four years incorporated with theory, practical and clinical posting hours in a respective year as per the KUHS syllabus.

P G programme 2 years unified with theory and practical training as per KUHS syllabus.

2.3. Relaxation in marks:

- **2.3.1.** For all the programs there will be usual mark relaxation as per the GO's issued by Government of Kerala for socially and Educationally Backward classes (SEBC) Scheduled Castes (SC), Scheduled Tribes (ST) and Other Eligible Castes (OEC).
- **2.3.2** Those candidates claiming relaxation of mark shall produce necessary certificate from the authority concerned. There will be no reservation of seats for SEBC and or SC/ST candidates under Management Quota.

2.4 Age:

Applicants should complete 17 year of age for degree / diploma programs on 31st December 2025. No age relaxation will be allowed.

3. How to apply

Availability of Prospectus: Prospectus can be downloaded from www.spmaonline.in.

3.1 Application for each programme (PG, UG, and Diploma) shall be submitted independently with prescribed *stipulated application fee separately* for each programme.

- 3.2 Application fee will be as ollows:
- 3.3 PG and UG: Rs. 1000/-

Diploma: Rs. 750/-

Application fee once remitted will not be refunded in any circumstances.

3.4 Remittance of Application Fee and Submission of Application Form

There will be **four stages** for the submission of Application form and all stages are mandatory. Candidates shall complete all the stages of submission as per the time schedule which will be notified through the website/media.

- Stage 1- Entering candidate personal details, uploading photo, signature, aadhar and creating a login id and password.
- Stage 2- Qualification details and college, course option
- Stage 3- Mark details and uploading marks card.
- Stage-4- Payment and submission.
 - *Students have to ensure that the details are correct before final submission. No need to send any printout of the application to any SPMA/colleges.

3.5 Remittance of Application Fee and Submission of Application in detail.

- i. Candidate shall visit the official website <u>www.spmaonline.in</u> and click "Apply online".
- ii. The personal details of the candidate have to be filled in the page
- iii. Candidate has to upload the Photo (JPG /PNG format 124px width & 160px height and Maximum size 25 kb) and signature of the candidate (Maximum size 20kb) and aadhar (in JPEG/PNG format up to 200 kb size).
- iv. Candidates can create a Password for future references.
- v. Enter qualification details and apply for course and 3 preferred college as your option
- vi. Enter marks of the qualifying examination and upload marklist. (in JPEG/PNG format up to 200kb size).
- vii. Candidate will be guided to Payment Screen. Application fee can be paid by Debit/Credit/Internet Banking facility/DD.(If the payment has done through DD, the DD to be uploaded and sent to the SPMA Administrative office.).
- viii. Application number will be generated and student can take print out of the application.
- 3.6 While applying the applicant should upload the following documents / or certificates duly attested by a gazetted officer or Head of the Institution last studied while applying online (Mandatory).
- 3.7 Application submission will be completed only after successful payment of application fee.
- 3.8 **The applicant need not to submit the print out of the application**. (If the payment has done through DD, the DD to be sent to the SPMA administrative office along with duly filled application).

- 3.9 One single application is sufficient to apply to all colleges. However, the candidate shall indicate their choice of college in the order of their preference in the online application form itself.
- 3.10 No opportunity will be given to incorporate any details or documents after the closing date of the application. Late and incomplete online applications will be rejected.
 - **4. Minority Quota**: The institutions having minority status, 15% seats of the total intake of all the courses will be reserved for the student's minority communities that such institutions represent.
 - **5. NRI Seats:** 15% of the total seats are marked for NRI candidates.

5.1 How to apply for NRI Seats:

The applicants for NRI seat should apply through SPMA online and opt colleges those who have NRI seats.

Documents required for NRI

- ✓ Sponsorship Certificate in the stamp paper & Declaration of the Sponsor.
- ✓ Employment Certificate of the Sponsor.
- ✓ Valid Passport copy of the Sponsor with Embassy Certificate/ Consulate/Green Card documents/OCI Documents of their respective sponsors. In case of non-submission of embassy certificate, the endorsement in the passport of the sponsor about the employment shall be accepted or employment contract.
- ✓ Visa Copy of the Sponsor with Embassy Attestation
- ✓ The attested copy of the relevant page of the passport where Employment Visa is stamped and if it is not submitted the employment certificate duly attested by the Indian Embassy or consulate.
- ✓ *Relationship Certificate from the Village Officer/Tahasildar
- *Relationship with the sponsor should comply the Government order in GO.(Rt).No.1616/2024/H&FWD, dated:04.07.2024 & GO.(Rt). No.1556/2024/H&FWD, dated:28.06.2024.

6. Preparation of Merit List

Merit list:

- ✓ Out of 50% management seats, 35% seats will be filled as Management merit seats and 15% of total seats as NRI seats shall be filled by SPMA from the online application received to the SPMA as per the eligibility criteria. The NRI seats will be as per the G.O (Rt) No.375/2020/H&FWD dated 22.02.2020 of Govt. of Kerala.
- ✓ The member institutions do not have NRI seats, 50% of the total seats (Management merit seats) will be filled by SPMA among the applications received to the SPMA on the basis of merit list prepared based on the marks obtained in the qualifying examination in the core subjects as mentioned in the eligibility criteria. If the NRI seats are not filled it will be converted as management seats.

- 7. Admission and Payment of fees- Selection by Centralised Allotment Process (CAP):
 - The Centralized Allotment Process for Management Seats in Private Self-financing Colleges for which the allotment is made through a Single Window System (SWS). The allotment to various colleges for PG,UG and Diploma courses will be done by SWS under the supervision of the AFRC. The allotments will be strictly based on the options exercised by the candidate.
- 7.1 The selected candidates will be intimated for the admission through SMS/email based on the allotment and rank list.
- 7.2 The Principal/Head of the Institution shall be responsible for verification of original documents / or certificates produced by the candidate at the time of admission in the college/institution.
- 7.3 The allotted candidates have to join the programme before the last date of allotment. The students who do not take admission within the stipulated date the admission will be cancelled.
- 7.4 **Cancellation of Admission- Payment of Fees-** The students shall pay all the fees for the 1st year of the course at the time of admission and which will not be refundable after closure of admission. For those who have selected and not paid the college fee within the prescribed date, the admission will be summarily cancelled and the seat will be allotted to the next eligible candidate.

If any candidate discontinues the course, after closing of admission as notified by the authority, the candidate has to follow the instruction/ clause given in the Govt.

Prospectus/ Claim if any for liquidated damages against any student shall be determined by appropriate proceedings before the competent Civil Court.

- ➤ Certificate of good conduct from the institution last attended issued within six months (original)
- ➤ Nativity certificate to prove nativity wherever is applicable.
- ➤ Birth Certificate (Copy)
- ➤ Income Certificate (Copy)
- ➤ In cases where the candidates claim any sort of reservation / preference provided for each college, documents to prove such claims as described in Annexure by each college.
- Certificate in proof of SEBC/OEC/SC/ST status obtained from Village Officer and certified by Tahsildar.
 - Aadhar (copy)
- > Fitness certificate to prove the disability
- Recent photographs taken in a white / light coloured back ground.
- > Other relevant documents of NRI candidates as per the Clause No.4.1

8 Spot Allotment: Spot allotment will be conducted based on the vacant seats including lapsed seats available in the member institutions. However the date and place of spot allotment will be duly intimated after obtaining permission from AFRC, the details regarding the availability of vacant seats, eligibility to attend, method of allotment etc.

9 General Information

The member institution has already submitted letters for signing the agreement for PG, UG and Diploma seat sharing with Govt. of Kerala (50% to Govt. 35% Management & 15% NRI). If for any reason, the Government is not willing to sign the agreement or allot the students, especially SC/ST/OEC, management will not be responsible to provide any concessional rate or relaxation of the fee.

10 Prohibition of Ragging:

- **10.1** According to the Kerala Prohibition of Ragging Act, 1998, 'ragging' means doing of any act by disorderly conduct to a student of an educational institution, which causes or is likely to cause physical or psychological harm or raising apprehension or shame or embarrassment to that student and includes teasing or abusing or playing practical jokes or causing hurt to such students or asking a student to do any act or to perform something which such student will not in the ordinary course be willing to do.
- **10.2** Ragging / any type of misconduct towards any student both on the College campus or outside will be considered a criminal offence and will be immediately reported to the police. Perpetrators will not be permitted to continue their studies.
- **10.3** Students and parents shall, at the time of admission, furnish an affidavit to the effect that the students will not implicate in ragging.

11 Special Instructions:

Use of mobile phones: Use of Mobile Phones by students is not permitted use in the campuses of any member colleges of association. Any violation of this prohibition will lead to stringent disciplinary action by the college authorities.

12 Code of conduct:

- **12.1** Every student is required to adhere strictly to the code of conduct of the institution to which he/she is admitted.
- **12.2** It is obligatory to wear the uniform of the institution in which the student is admitted.
- **12.3**. Any other items not specifically covered in this prospectus will be decided by the undersigned, and his decision shall be final.
- ** MSc Optometry/MSc.MLT admission schedules will be finalized as per the UG result of the concerned course by the KUHS.
